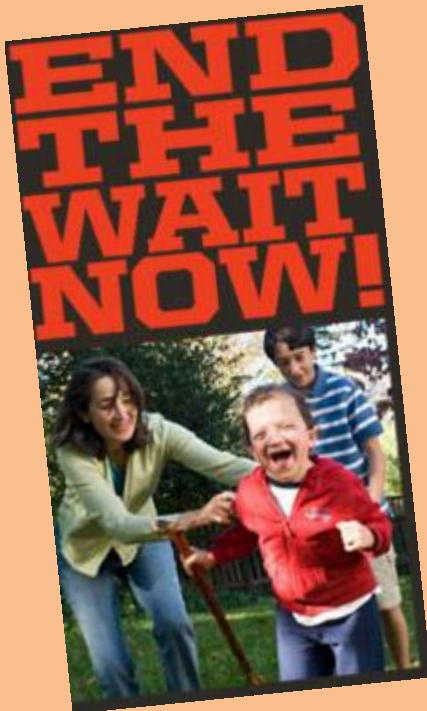


# Announcing New ETWN Staff
