Funding Developmental Disabilities Services How Maryland Rates¹

Maryland is the wealthiest state in the nation,² yet....

- ❖ Maryland ranks 43rd in the nation in terms of state spending on developmental disabilities services.
- ❖ Only eight states rank lower: Alabama, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Nevada, Texas and Virginia.

The measure used is referred to as “fiscal effort,” which is a ratio that ranks states according to the proportion of their aggregate statewide personal income devoted to the financing of developmental disability services. Some states are financing developmental disability services more vigorously than others. Comparative state fiscal effort analysis enables distinctions to be made between those states making a strong effort and those that are not.³
